Juniper is open for move-ins and we are thrilled to welcome new residents to our communities!

While the recent COVID-19 outbreak has left all of us often feeling confused and with many unanswered questions, our goal has been to be a resource you can trust. Being transparent about our prevention and preparedness while sharing important health information has been our approach, so you can be empowered and informed. That transparent approach continues as we begin our pathway forward, “Safer Together”. We hope this outline of our enhanced move-in process will be helpful in your decision to move to senior living.

- **Personalized Care** - New move-ins are welcomed into our community after a thorough assessment of resident needs, values, and desires
- **Complete Sanitation** - Prior to move-in, the suite is cleaned and disinfected using “Juniper’s White Glove Green Clean” program
- **Assisted Move-in** - We have a team of associates who assist with the physical move-in process on move-in day; this

allows family to focus on their loved one not the furniture!

- **Precautionary Self-Isolation** - Due to required precautions around COVID-19 prevention, new residents are tested prior to move-in, then again on move-in day, and again after 72 hours. If these test results are negative, self-isolation is no longer required. Depending on test results and result timeline, self-isolation could be as short as 5 days.

During the period of self-isolation, residents are provided with all of their normal care and service **plus**
