TYPES OF COMMUNITIES

- Assisted Living: long-term care for elderly or disabled persons who are able to get around on their own but may need help with some activities of daily living, or simply prefer the convenience of having their meals in a central dining room and having nursing staff available.
- Assisted Living for Alzheimer's Care: assisted living but with an innovative design for living that supports active independence for those with progressive memory loss.
- Personal Care: a solution offering the elderly the comfort of professional care services with the ability to live and take care of themselves to the extent possible, similar in scope of service to assisted living.
- Independent Living: the least restrictive living option, the communities are designed for seniors to live independently with a minimal level of assistance. This can be a first step in a transitional program to more care in the future.
- CCRC/Life Plan Community: offering both Type A and Type C life plan contracts, including independent living, personal care, memory care, and skilled nursing/rehabilitation.
- Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitative Care: 24-hour care for people who can no longer care for themselves due to physical, emotional, or mental conditions or need nursing and physical therapy to further recover from a hospital stay before going home.
- Long-term Behavioral Health Care: 24 hour care with a broad spectrum of therapies for its residents including individual psychotherapy, psychotropic medication management, behavior management and rehabilitation support services.
